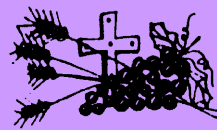

Parish Membership: Active parishioners are those who:

- are baptized and attend Mass weekly
- receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation at least yearly
- fill out a Registration Form and a Stewardship Commitment Form
- use their church contribution envelopes for the Sunday collection
- dedicate Time and Talent to the life of their parish

Sacrament of Baptism: Baptisms are usually celebrated on the fourth Sunday of the month. Baptism Preparation Classes are required for both Catholic parents. (Parents who are not Catholic are urged to attend.) Pre-registration is required. Call Connie Sandlin at the Parish Office, ext. 15.

Sacrament of Reconciliation: Saturday at 3:30 pm or by appointment.

Sacrament of Marriage: The Archdiocesan policy requires a six month notification to the parish priest.

Anointing of the Sick: Contact the Parish Office to request the sacrament for yourself or a family member. Please notify the pastor when you or a loved one is in the hospital.

Christian Initiation of Adults and Children (RCIA & RCIC): Each year the Parish community welcomes those interested in learning more about the Catholic faith. These sessions begin in the Fall and continue through the Spring. For more information call the Parish Office.

Giving Living - Weekly Reflection

CLEAN SWEEP

Lent again! Sigh. What shall we give up this year? If we think only of depriving ourselves, we miss the point. Lent is a time not for depriving ourselves but for spiritual spring cleaning before Easter. The Church recommends fasting, prayer, and almsgiving to help convert our hearts to God and to grow as disciples of Jesus. For fasting, try eating less, or eating healthier foods. Fast from damaging behavior, such as gossip, anger, immorality, or misuse of alcohol. Add different kinds of prayer to your daily life and be more mindful as you pray at Mass. During Lent focus on more acts of charity and mercy. Give alms by helping friends and neighbors out of tight situations or being more generous to employees. Perhaps you can increase your giving to your parish and worthy charities such as the Saint Vincent de Paul Society, Catholic Relief Services, or Catholic Charities.

***Conscience Rights, Religious Liberty Violated by
Sweeping HHS Contraceptive Mandate***

On January 20, the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) reaffirmed a rule that virtually all private health care plans must cover sterilization, abortifacients, and contraception.

The exemption provided for "religious employers" is so narrow that it fails to cover the vast majority of faith-based organizations, including Catholic hospitals, universities, and service organizations that help millions every year. Ironically, not even Jesus & his disciples would have qualified, because of their commitment to serve others.

To correct this threat to religious liberty and conscience rights, the Respect for Rights of Conscience Act has been introduced in Congress (H.R. 1179, S. 1467). This measure will ensure that those who participate in the health care system "retain the right to provide, purchase, or enroll in health coverage that is consistent with their religious beliefs and moral convictions." It is more important than ever that Members of Congress be urged to co-sponsor this measure – or thanked if they are already co-sponsoring the bill. MESSAGE: "Please co-sponsor the Respect for Rights of Conscience Act (H.R. 1179, S. 1467) and help enact it into law. Please ensure that the rights of conscience of all participants in our nation's health care system are respected."

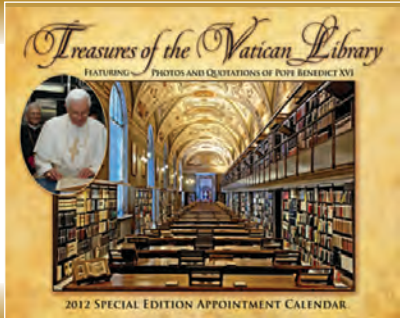

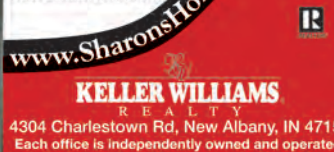
