Kindergarten = **Sheep** (black long sleeve shirt and black pants with a white t-shirt/jacket/hoodie)

First Grade = **Sheep** (black long sleeve shirt and black pants with a white t-shirt/jacket/hoodie)

Second Grade = Angels (White clothes -halo & angel wings are fine, but **not required**).

Third Grade = Magi (Similar to shepherds, but solid colors – red, blue, purple, gold, etc)

Fourth Grade = Angels (White clothes -halo & angel wings are fine, but **not required**)

Fifth Grade = Shepherds (Pillow case or towel over head and tunic with rope around head and/or waist.)

* If a costume is inaccessible, the student is welcome to wear school uniform (white uniform shirt, and navy slacks or skirts)... Costumes are available from orientaltrading.com at a very reasonable price, or can easily be made.
