Parents, this test will help us to measure the progress that the students have made during the school year; therefore, it is important that you talk to your students about doing their best.

Some bills may be wrong since the parents have not completed the Choice Scholarship Application or the SGO Application. If you still need to do this, please call the office and make an appointment to complete the application
