This is a co-ed team for students in 2nd-8th grade.

Tuesday, July 18th from 5:30-7:00 at Sacred Heart School gym (1840 E. 8th Street Jeffersonville) located behind the school Southern Indiana Catholic Cross Country will be holding an open registration. Student must be registered and all required paperwork turned in no later than **Friday August 4th**. The regular season meets and practices are August-October 1st.

Please bring a current athletic physical. All participants are required to turn in a current athletic physical to begin practicing. Practices will begin the last week of July for middle school runners and first week of August for younger runners.

Registration fee is \$45 per runner and a uniform (running singlet) deposit of \$30 (this will be a separate check and will not be cashed unless uniform is not returned). Uniform shorts are only required to be purchased for middle school runners and are \$20. **No child will be turned away from participating because of ability to pay.**
