Keeping Accounts Current

ISTEP+ Testing/IREAD

Students in grades 3 through 8 will begin ISTEP+ testing on Monday, February 26th and will test through the week. Students in grade 3 will take the IREAD Test beginning on Monday, March 5th. It is very important that the students get a good night's sleep, eat a healthy breakfast, and be at school on time. Tardy students will have to remain in the office if their class has stated the test. Please, it is very important for your child to be at school each day and on time so that we do not have to arrange for make-up testing time.
