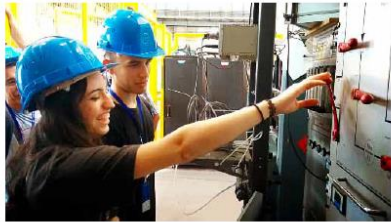

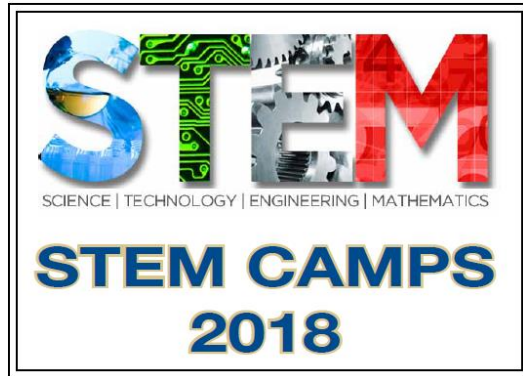

### What are the Providence STEM Camps?

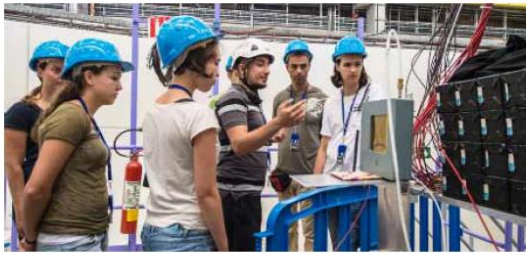
A week of lessons and activities centered on STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Math) for up to 18 campers per age group/session.
