## **Tuition Information**

Tuition invoices for the 2018-19 school year were sent home last week. **Please complete the bottom portion and turn it in to the school office along with the first tuition payment for next year by Friday, May 18<sup>th</sup>.** This first payment must be made by check, cash, money order or credit card. **IT WILL NOT BE AUTOMATICALLY DEDUCTED FROM YOUR BACK ACCOUNT.**

If you chose to pay in 10 monthly installments, the remaining 9 payments will be withdrawn from your back account August through April once you complete a new Automatic Bank Payment Authorization form.
