IMPORTANT WEATHER REMINDERS

- Several weeks ago we sent home the information regarding school closing due to inclement weather. Please, REMEMBER, WE ARE ON OUR OWN AND YOU NEED TO LOOK FOR ST. ANTHONY SCHOOL for closings and delays. You may watch the local television stations, check our website, check the Parent Facebook Page, or call the school phone answering machine.
- If we are on a one-hour delay, then the school doors open at 8:00 AM and school begins at 8:50 AM. If we are on a 2-hour delay, the doors of the school will open at 8:00 AM, but school will begin at 9:50 AM.
- If the school goes on a delay and you are uncomfortable with the roads, you always have the right to keep your child at home. Ultimately, you have the final decision if you want your child to attend school.
- If the school is on a 1 or 2-hour delay, then the Pre School classes will still meet. Doors to the Pre School building will open at 8:00 AM.
- Once the students are at school, we **do not close early.** If you feel that you need to come and take your child home, you may, but they will be counted absent.
